traditional Christian scriptures" (Tenzin: 48). He also commented on the "striking stylistic similarities between the Christian and Buddhist scriptures" (Tenzin: 55). The Dalai Lama's willingness to engage Christian Scriptures reveals his tolerance and respect for non-Buddhist faiths and their texts, but with this openness he also stresses the importance of maintaining the uniqueness of the world's religions lest we try to reduce everything and then "have nothing left to show that is distinct about our specific traditions" (Tenzin: 73).

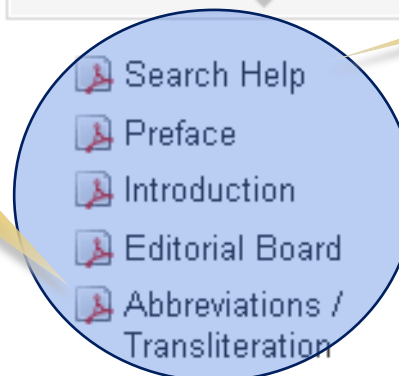

Search

To search the database *EBR Online* enter your search term(s) into the entry fields in the search form on the left hand side of the screen. Three entry fields are available, each of them is preset with a search criterium. You can select a different search criterium from the list available for each entry field. The result of your search is always an encyclopedic article.

The following search criteria are available:

- **Full Text:**
searches through the full text of all entries in the database. With this search criterium you will receive a multitude of hits, because you always search through the full entries. To perform a more targeted search, please use one of the other search criteria.
- **Title:**
with this search criteria you can search all titles of articles within EBR.
