Law Journal Library

It includes the periodic consolidation of the Statutes of Canada, incorporating amendments and acts that have been added since the last revision. To date, there have been six revisions: 1886, 1906, 1927, 1952, 1970, and 1985.

Slavery in America and the World: History, Culture & Law

World Treaty Library*


